



Dear Stallion Owner:

Everyone wants a winner! When mare owners are choosing a stallion, they are looking for an outstanding individual to sire their future champion. When people are looking to purchase a young horse, not only are they looking at the bloodlines, they are looking for the potential of the horse.

Nominating your stallion to the **CANADIAN SUPREME** Breeders Group program is the way to improve the number and quality of mares in your stallion's court.

Here is how the program works.

- I. Stallion owners must nominate their stallions by **July 1st** (of the year that he has yearlings on the ground) for \$800.
- II. The stallion owner provides a **2015 breeding report**, which lists the mares that produced foals that are **yearlings in 2017**. The stallion owner must provide a complete list of all mare owners including email addresses.
- III. The mare owners are contacted by the Canadian Supreme and are made aware of the opportunity provided by the stallion owner and should they choose, they will nominate their yearlings into the program for a fee of \$100 for each yearling. The deadline for yearling nominations is **December 31, 2017**.
- IV. The money from stallion and yearling nominations is put into term deposits and will be the purse for the 2019 Canadian Supreme 3 and 4 year old classes.
- V. Owners of the nominated horses enter the Futurity classes in their 3-year-old year.

Each year the Canadian Supreme awards the leading sire in each discipline with a free stallion nomination for the following year. The following stallions will receive a free nomination in 2017:

- Leading Cutting Sire - **Dually Cat** owned by Gerry & Sandy Hansma
- Leading Cow Horse Sire - **High Sign Nugget** owned by Jim Dobler & Heather McLevin
- Leading Reining Sire - **Hesa Smart Chic** owned by Locke & Deb Duce and Jeff & Jesse Beckley

The Junior Stallion program is for stallions whose offspring are not yet yearlings. The cost is \$250 each year and they receive the same advertising and promotion as senior stallions.

Stakes money, along with yearling nomination money, is placed into a term deposit to collect interest until the 2019 show when it is paid out as added money in the Canadian Supreme 3 and 4 year old classes.

STALLION NOMINATION PROCEDURE

1. Complete the enclosed Stallion Nomination Form.
2. Attach a copy of the Stallion's Registration Papers.
3. Submit a complete **2015** breeding report including all mares bred, all breeds as well as grade mares.
4. Attach a complete list of all mare owners' names, addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses.
5. Enclose promotional information for the trade fair booth. A photo of your stallion or his offspring and one page of information naming accomplishments, breeding information, etc.
6. Submit payment by cheque payable to the Canadian Supreme or credit card information.

New for 2017: The Canadian Supreme will now accept late foal nominations for foals of Canadian Supreme nominated sires. The stallion must have been previously nominated in the year that the offspring was a yearling. A complete list of stallion nominations for late foal nominations is on the website. The cost is \$100 for a yearling, \$500 for a 2 year old, \$1,000 for a 3 or 4 year old.

Stallion Nominations and all requirements must be mailed to the address listed below on or before July 1, 2017.

Stallion Nominations received after July 1, 2017 or received incomplete will be charged a \$200 late penalty.

WHAT IS IT?

The CANADIAN SUPREME FUTURITIES is an incentive program designed to enhance the CANADIAN SUPREME horse show held each fall in Red Deer, Alberta.

The program is designed so that everyone who participates has an opportunity to benefit and compete. It involves all elements of the horse industry, stallion owners, mare owners, horse owners, competitors and trainers.

Following is a brief outline of how everyone involved can reap the benefits.

STALLION OWNERS

By nominating a stallion into this affordable program, the stallion owner is giving the owner who breeds their mare, or purchases an offspring an opportunity to participate in the three and four year old programs and compete for more than \$50,000 in cash and prizes. In return the stallion owner receives advertising and exposure for their stallion at the show as well as throughout the year.

MARE OWNERS

By breeding their mares to nominated stallions, mare owners are increasing the value of their offspring. Having offspring which are eligible for a program with large prize money incentive is an excellent and affordable marketing tool.

HORSE OWNER

By nominating your yearling, or purchasing a nominated horse, you have the opportunity to compete for over \$50,000 in cash and prizes at the CANADIAN SUPREME show in the three and four year old programs.

HOW DO YOU TAKE PART?

STALLION OWNERS:

The stallion owner pays an annual fee of \$800 to nominate the stallion into the program. The stallion must be nominated by July 1st of the year that he has yearlings on the ground. This entitles all his yearling offspring to be nominated. All yearlings regardless of breed or pedigree are welcome.

The CANADIAN SUPREME requires a breeding report, with contact information for the yearlings and will subsequently contact the owners.

OWNERS OF OFFSPRING Sired BY CANADIAN SUPREME STALLIONS

You will be sent a nomination form in the fall of their yearling year. You can nominate your horse for a one-time only fee of \$100 prior to December 31st of their yearling year.

NO OTHER PAYMENTS ARE REQUIRED UNTIL THESE HORSES ARE READY TO COMPETE.
