Dear competitors, owners, stallion owners, sponsors and friends:

In February, the Canadian Supreme announced that the reining classes will no longer be held at the show. We are happy to announce that Mike Santangelo from the Silver Slate Arena has agreed to hold the Canadian Supreme nominated three and four-year-old reining classes at the Silver Slate Fall Slide scheduled for October 5 to 7, 2018.

The four classes (Open and Non Pro 3-year-old and Open and Non Pro 4-year-old) will be very similar to how they were run at the Canadian Supreme:

- The classes will be National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) approved and judged by two NRHA judges.
- There will be champion and reserve champion prizes in each of the four classes.
- The three-year-old horses can be shown one or two handed in any legal bit.
- The three-year-old classes will be two goes, with payout money to each go and payout money to the aggregate.
- The four-year-old classes will be one go.

**Canadian Supreme Futurities Classes** (Open to 2014 and 2015 pre-subscribed foals only)

Added money paid out on a pro-rated bases according to entries.

- NRHA Level 4 CS Open Reining Futurity – 3 Yr Old
- NRHA Level 4 CS Non Pro Reining Futurity – 3 Yr Old
- NRHA Level 4 CS Open Reining Derby – 4 Yr Old
- NRHA Level 4 CS Non Pro Reining Derby – 4 Yr Old

**Please note: The deadline to enter the Canadian Supreme nominated three and four-year-old reining classes is September 9, 2018 at 5:00 PM. No late entries will be accepted.**

Entries for the four Canadian Supreme Reining classes should be sent directly to the Canadian Supreme office by mail, fax or e-mail.

The Silver Slate Fall Slide also holds their own slate of NRHA approved reining classes. Please see the Silver Slate website for entry details. The entry details and deadlines may be different than the deadline for the Canadian Supreme Reining classes.

## **REINING COMPETITORS**

- \* All participating reining owners and riders must be current members of the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA). Horses must have a valid NRHA competition license to compete. Please submit photocopies of all required NRHA competition license(s) and membership cards (owner and rider) with entries.
- \* National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) rules apply to all reining classes and NRHA patterns will be used.
- \* By signing the entry form all reining competitors confirm that they possess a current NRHA membership and all non pros confirm that they possess a current NRHA non pro card.
- \* Class Eligibility is based on the riders' and/or the horses' earnings as of January 1 of the current NRHA year. It is the responsibility of the owner and/or rider to be aware of the official earnings of the horse and/or rider as recorded by NRHA. NRHA eligibility lists are available at [www.nrha.com](http://www.nrha.com).
- \* The Canadian Supreme will retain 15% of entry fees for the Canadian Supreme Futurity/Derby reining classes.

## **CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION AWARDS IN ALL CLASSES**

### **SUBSTITUTION POLICY**

After the September 9<sup>th</sup> deadline an injured horse may be substituted within the class if written verification from an approved Veterinarian is received and a \$100 substitution fee is paid. The substituted horse must belong to the same owner and a copy of the registration certificate must be provided. If the substitution is received after the draw but prior to the start of the event the substituted horse will work in the original draw position.

### **CLASS ENTRY/REPLACEMENT SLOTS**

Class Entry/Replacement slots are available if an owner needs to scratch an entry but does not have a horse to substitute in the slot. This slot may now be sold to another owner that has a horse for that slot. Class entry/replacement slots cannot change classes or divisions. Slots may be sold up to 5:00 PM the day before the class starts. The seller of the slot must submit written confirmation naming the buyer of the slot. The buyer must submit a completed entry form, a copy of the horse papers and pay the \$100 class entry/replacement slot fee prior to 5:00 PM the day before the class starts. Available slots will be listed on the Canadian Supreme website.

### **TIE BREAKERS**

All ties for 1st place will be broken if the tied exhibitors agree to a run-off. Tied exhibitors may choose not to run-off, agreeing instead to be named co-champions, but must determine the winner of the awards by a mutually agreed upon tiebreaker such as a flip of a coin. However, when one exhibitor opts to run-off and the other does not, the exhibitor who declines to run-off will forfeit 1<sup>st</sup> place to the other(s).
